Senator Onder is a lifelong Missourian, elected to the Missouri Senate in 2014, who is now finishing his second term representing the 2nd District in St. Charles County. He received his A.B. and his M.D. from Washington University in St. Louis, and his J.D. from St. Louis University School of Law. Prior to his entry into politics, Senator Onder worked as a medical doctor who is board certified in Allergy and Immunology and Internal Medicine. He is also the founder of Midwest Clinical Research, L.L.C.

During his time in the Missouri Senate he served for three years as Assistant Majority Floor Leader, and was instrumental in the passage of pro-life legislation, including the 2017 law protecting pregnancy care centers and the 2019 "Heartbeat" law, as well as bills protecting religious liberty, education choice and parental rights in education.

Senator Onder is married to his wife Allison, and is a father of six children. He was a founding member of St. Gianna Catholic Church in 2006 which remains his parish to this day. He and his family reside in Lake St. Louis, Missouri.

Ken Battis is a lifelong STL Catholic who has over 30 years experience of dealing with the abuse cases inside the Catholic Church. He has taken an active role in leading the STL laity through awareness of their canonical rights.
